### Term 1

Developing a Christian Worldview - February 3-17

**1. (Feb. 3) Where has truth gone?** Christian living in a society of relativism.

We hear many different statements in our culture about truth - "my truth", "there is no absolute truth", "live your truth". Many people now largely attempt to reduce truth to opinion or preferences and often based on feelings. However, our faith is based on truth - what actually corresponds with reality; indeed Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life, and the truth sets us free. - **2.** (Feb. 10) What's happening with religious freedom in Australia? Biblical priorities in living out our faith in contemporary Australia. We'll look at the current challenges to religious freedom in our nation and how we can practically, actively, and in a Christ honouring way explain the essence and importance of religious freedom, and regardless of the circumstances, be witnesses to the beauty, power, and life changing nature & hope of the Gospel.
- **3. (Feb. 17) Biblical sexual ethics in changing times.** Holding to Scriptural truth in a culture of self determination.

Our culture's understanding of Identity, gender, and the nature of relationships continues to significantly change. In such changing times, we are to stand firm on Scripture and lovingly explain and live out the Biblical position including how God is seen and glorified in these essentials.
